

## Scripture is Inspired by God

### 2 Timothy 3: 14 – 4:2

In today's Bible story, we will again hear from Paul's letter to Timothy. As a teacher, Paul wanted to make sure Timothy was prepared to live out his faith in the world. Paul knew that Timothy would be faced with lots of challenges and if he didn't have the tools, he would lose his faith.

That's why Paul assured Timothy that he would always be on the right path of his faith if he used **THIS** every day.

### **Let's begin the 2<sup>nd</sup> letter from Paul to Timothy....**

The object in this box has to do with the truth. It has to do with what we are taught and believe. Your teachers have used this because it gives you the wisdom that leads to salvation through faith in Jesus Christ.

It's inspired by God and is useful for teaching the truth, rebuking error, correcting mistakes, and giving instruction for right living so that the person who serves God may be fully qualified and equipped to do every kind of good deed. You are encouraged to share its message with others in the presence of God and Jesus who will judge the living and the dead.

When Timothy was growing in his faith, he was surrounded by false teachers. Paul knew that Timothy may have a tough time following his faith if he didn't stay true to the teachings in the Bible.
