Over the next few weeks, mediate and pray a decade for one **Luminous Mystery** a day. Choose freely from the readings for each mystery from the chart below. When you come back to a mystery again, try to choose a different reading from a different gospel, where possible, or a different section of the larger readings.

The 4 movements of *lectio divina*:

<i>lectio</i>	read	Read
<i>meditatio</i>	meditate	Reflect
<i>oratio</i>	pray	Respond
<i>contemplatio</i>	contemplate	Rest

The 5th Movement is **Action** (acting on what you gained from the first 4 movements)
