PRE-AUTHORIZED GIVING PLAN – PAG

Our parish is where we spend some of the most important moments of our lives. It is where we are married and bring our children to be baptized. It is where we come to be fed in the Holy Eucharist, be reconciled with God and the world, and hope to leave this world on our final journey to meet the God we love. The operation and maintenance of our Parish is made possible through the generous and regular offertory giving of our parishioners. In response to changing lifestyles and demands of our time, the PAG program will help establish a systematic giving program for parishioners. To date, we have 203 families using the Pre-Authorized Giving Plan with a total of \$17,938 monthly contribution. Our parish goal is to reach \$20,000.
