## PARISH MEMORIAL WALL – A NEW INITIATIVE...

We are planning to create a Memorial Wall in the south narthex area inside the Ribblesdale doors. As a faith community we are called to honour the memory of those who have gone before us, entrusting them to God's eternal care. This memorial wall will offer a lasting tribute to the lives and legacies of our family members, friends and parishioners who now rest in Christ's peace.

We wish to create a sacred space where we can name our loved ones and pray and reflect on their lives who helped shape our families and our faith community here at Holy Family.

The wall is intended to be a permanent tribute site. The engravable material we will use is marble. The wooden cross will be made from repurposed chair rail remaining from the renovation and will be backlit for a beautiful presentation. Each 4" x 6" plaque allocation will be engraved with the name and date of your loved one's year of birth and passing or honouring a group family name without dates i.e. "Deceased Members of the Smith Family". We will have limited plaques available to complete the wall. The cost per plaque will be \$300.00 and will be available on a first come first serve basis.

## RECOGNITION WALL
